Drug Awareness Poster Contest Guidelines

Note: Underage drinking and alcohol abuse, marijuana use, and prescription and over-the-counter drug abuse are persistent problems in our community. We would like to give students in grades 5 – 6 the opportunity to participate in a poster contest that will focus on these issues. We would like for each student to create a poster to send a message about the dangers of abusing these substances and/or the benefits of not abusing these substances. All participating school corporations will have a minimum of 1 winner awarded an iPod Shuffle. The grand prize winner will receive an iPod Touch and be placed on the cover. After the grand prize and the school corporation winners are selected, the remaining entrants will be reviewed for Wild Card selection to the calendar. The Wild Card Winners will also receive an iPod Shuffle. Please see the guidelines below. We have also attached a brief educational page to share with students to demonstrate the problem that is facing our community.

- All submissions must contain a message centering on one or all of the substances named above. Students can utilize creative ways to show the benefits of not abusing these drugs and/or the dangers and consequences related when someone does abuse them.
- Submissions need to be in color on 8.5" X 11" paper only. Only artwork running horizontally will be considered.
- Product names should not be used.
- Only one entry per student.
- All posters will become the property of Neighborhoods Against Substance Abuse.
- Posters will be judged according to their originality and effectiveness of conveying their message.
- Students need to put name, school, and grade on the back of the drawing in pencil.
- All entries must be submitted to the appropriate school staff person.
- Each school building will select their Top 7 posters to submit to NASA by 3 p.m. on October 27th, 2015. NASA will then select the winner from each school.
- All winners selected will be invited to NASA's Annual Luncheon, November 20, 2015, to receive their award. Parents will be invited to attend as well.
